<p>Proxy can view (full access – no restrictions) (Available since Oct 2009)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Make requests (med/appt/referral/preference) • Registration Information • Messages • Medication List • Allergy List • Immunizations • Appointments • Results • Reports (Radiology) • Provider Letters • Visit Summary Reports (if printed by the practice) • Pre Visit Form (if sent by the practice) 	<p>Proxy and patients with self account can view (restricted access) (Available May 2011)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Make requests med**/appt/referral/preference • **medication data from medical record is not displayed • Registration Information • Allergy List • Immunizations • Appointments • **Option for sender to share messages** • The Pre Visit and Visit Summary Reports are NOT available for Pedi Teen. <p>Access</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Parent/Legal Guardian may authorize access for themselves or a PCR [using paper form, scanned into chart] • Access terminates when patient turns 13 • One month prior to the child's 13th birthday, the proxy receives an alert about termination • If a teen proxy is signed, the access switches over when the child turns 13. This can only be done one month prior • Parent or Practice can request termination at any time • Only 1 signed consent is required for proxy access. If the patient goes to multiple pedi practices/specialty practices, they don't need to have one form per practice. 	<p>Access</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Parent/Legal Guardian <i>and</i> patient may authorize "teen" access for parents and patient (but not anyone else) [using paper form, scanned into chart] • Teen self account can be created but requires at least one PCR to be linked to their account. • Access terminates for parent/legal guardian when patient turns 18 • Teen retains access • Parent, Teen or Practice can request termination at any time • Only one signed consent is required for proxy access. If the patient goes to multiple pedi practices/specialty practices, they don't need to have one form per practice. 	<p>Access</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Patient may authorize access for themselves or a PCR (patient care representative)[using paper form, scanned into chart] • Patient or Practice can request termination at any time • Only one signed consent is required for proxy access.
